The Arts & Crafts Ministry is a Fellowship Ministry of the Circle of Care.

The Fellowship Ministries Mission Statement:

Arrange opportunities to encourage periodic fellowship with members of the congregation who have similar interests or are in similar phases of life.

The Arts & Crafts ministry arranges opportunities for people with similar arts or crafts skills to gather together for fellowship and fun! For example, a group of “yarners” gathers every Tuesday in the Fellowship Hall to knit and crochet and “talk about the weather” or solve all the world’s problems. They encourage one another and have an enjoyable time together while creating items for the Barnabas ministry, children’s homes, shut-ins, hospitals, and other organizations. If you want to learn how to knit or crochet, the sisters will show you how!

Once a month the Sewing group gets together in the Fellowship Hall to make lap quilts or pillow cases or other projects which are then donated to a nursing home or other charitable facility in the name of Jesus Christ. Sewing machines are available, but you’re welcome to bring your own.

Other Arts & Crafts groups can be organized if there are enough people interested, such as Scrapbooking, Card Making, Painting, Watercolor, Drawing, you name it!
