The Conduct Individual Bible Studies Ministry is a Missions Ministry of the Circle of Care.

The Missions Ministries Mission Statement:

Encourage and equip the brethren to proclaim the Gospel to the Lost.

The Conduct Individual Bible Study ministry helps local people who are seeking God to find Him! Contacts are usually made through the Visitor Follow-up ministry. However, this isn't the only way. People willing to conduct a one-on-one Bible study are few and sometimes those who have come to us seeking God end up going elsewhere because we couldn't reach them in time. We have a couple different kinds of lessons which can be used to lead a seeking soul to Christ: God's Plan for Me - see the Office; and a great study of Acts 2 - see Rich Howell. Of course there are other methods and lessons with which you may be more familiar and you're welcome to use those. You can support the Conduct Individual Bible Study ministry in the following ways:

- Meet and greet visitors before and after the Assemblies, encouraging them to engage in a Bible Study
- Pray for those seeking God
- Seek opportunities outside of the assemblies to engage people in a Bible Study
- Once a study has been set up, keep the appointment. Typically, it takes 2 to 8 one-hour sessions to lead a soul to Christ. Sometimes longer.
- When a person obeys the gospel and is baptized into Christ, continue to disciple that person by "teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you." ~ Jesus, as recorded in Matt 28:20
