Visitor Follow-Up Ministry

The Visitor Follow-Up Ministry is a Missions Ministry of the Circle of Care.

The Missions Ministries Mission Statement:

Encourage and equip the brethren to proclaim the Gospel to the Lost.

The Visitor Follow-Up Ministry responds to visitors who have expressed a desire to know more about Jesus Christ, or more about the church of Christ, or more about their relationship with God. Oftentimes the Visitor Follow-up results in an Individual Bible Study, in which case the visitor's name would be given to a member to set up the study. You can support the Visitor Follow-Up ministry in the following ways:

- Meet and greet visitors before and after the Assemblies, encouraging them to fill out a White Card
- Send a Thank You card to every first-time visitor the week of the visit
- Send a follow-up letter to local first-time visitors 3 weeks after sending thank you card
- Upon request, meet with the visitor to learn of their needs and questions
- Pray for the visitors each week
- If the visitor desires a Bible Study, either study with the person or give the visitor's name to the Visitor Follow-Up Ministry Organizer who will ensure a study is arranged with the visitor
