LUKE 24: The women His empty tomb, the angels' announcement, and His disciples (#17) $\rightarrow$ Jesus appears to two on the Emmaus Road $\rightarrow$ Jesus appears to the eleven, and more, in the upper room $\rightarrow$ Jesus' global Commission (#18) $\rightarrow$ Jesus ascends, His disciples!
