

"Uncommon Sense" from The Proverbs, Pt 2

BOOK INTRODUCTION:

- 1) A proverb is a short, pithy statement of wisdom, wit or irony. Written proverbs date back to Hammurabi (2000 BC), and were also prevalent in the ancient cultures of the Far East – most notably in the writings and recorded annals of Confucius (551-479 BC?).*
- 2) The Hebrew word for proverb (mashal) is defined as "A rule in the form of similitude, representation or comparison." Proverbs are rules for living right before God and man. And these rules are not merely stated, they are often illustrated with clear, concise pictures from everyday life.*
- 3) According to 1 Kings 3:7-15 and 4:29-34, we learn that God gave King Solomon (971-931 BC) a degree of wisdom beyond all who have ever lived (except for Jesus – Mat 12:42!). We also learn that Solomon wrote 3,000 proverbs (of which 800-900 are recorded in this book, and another 100 or so in Ecclesiastes). He also wrote 1005 songs, which most likely include the Song of Songs!*
- 4) I've heard it said that Proverbs is just a book of good old fashioned "common sense" but I prefer calling this inspired collection "Uncommon Sense!" What we read in this book is a higher wisdom that Yahweh God graciously gave to King Solomon to enlighten, guide and bless all wisdom-seeking people of every generation!.*
